- **Computer Skills:** Interns are expected to master our proprietary online database. It is taken as read that interns will be fully conversant with MS Office applications;
- **Languages:** Written and spoken English must be very good. Other languages of interest: German, French, Italian, Portuguese, Spanish, Japanese, Chinese, Korean. Some evidence of writing ability is required;
- **Sense of humour:** We expect to have fun, even if we are working hard!
